Internship -- Fall, 2017

Soc 495: Sociology Internship (3) Job-related opportunity to intern with a public agency, a private company, or a non-profit organization providing practical experience and application of sociological ideas while being supervised by on-site professional and course instructor.

Pre: Soc 300 and junior or senior standing and consent.

The internships will start in the Fall and run for 15 weeks. Each intern will work 10 hours weekly with a supervisor for a total of 150 hours. The internship might be a volunteer or paid position. Students will keep a weekly journal of their duties and activities. All material is strictly confidential. Each student will meet with me once a month individually and not as a class. I will visit his/her site once during the semester. Readings on the topic (roughly two books equivalent) will be assigned as mutually agreed upon and discussed. The final paper will be a 5-6 page paper about one's their learning experience. These internships are successful for students and employers.
